






# Word Work Choice Board

<p><b><u>Shaving Cream Words</u></b></p> <p>Write your words in shaving cream...<i>please do not put this in your Journal</i> 😊</p> 	<p><b><u>Silly Sentences</u></b></p> <p>Choose 10 words from your list and create a silly sentence with each word, make sure your sentences have are more than 7 words in length...short and sweet will not cut it.</p> <p>Have you ever seen a <u>whale</u> with a polka-dotted tale down by the bay?</p>	<p><b><u>Word Connect</u></b></p> <p>Try to use as many words as possible from your list and connect them, similar to a crossword puzzle.</p> <p>School o o Kite</p>
<p><b><u>Letter/Postcard</u></b></p> <p>Write me a letter or postcard using at least 10 of your words.</p> 	<p><b><u>Word Collage</u></b></p> <p>Cut out letters from a magazine or newspaper to create your words.</p> 	<p><b><u>Type Your Words</u></b></p> <p>Type your words then paste them into Journal, if you don't have a printer, have your parent sign off that you completed the task.</p>
